Figure A1. Clusters of mean *Peón* and *Maestro* wages.

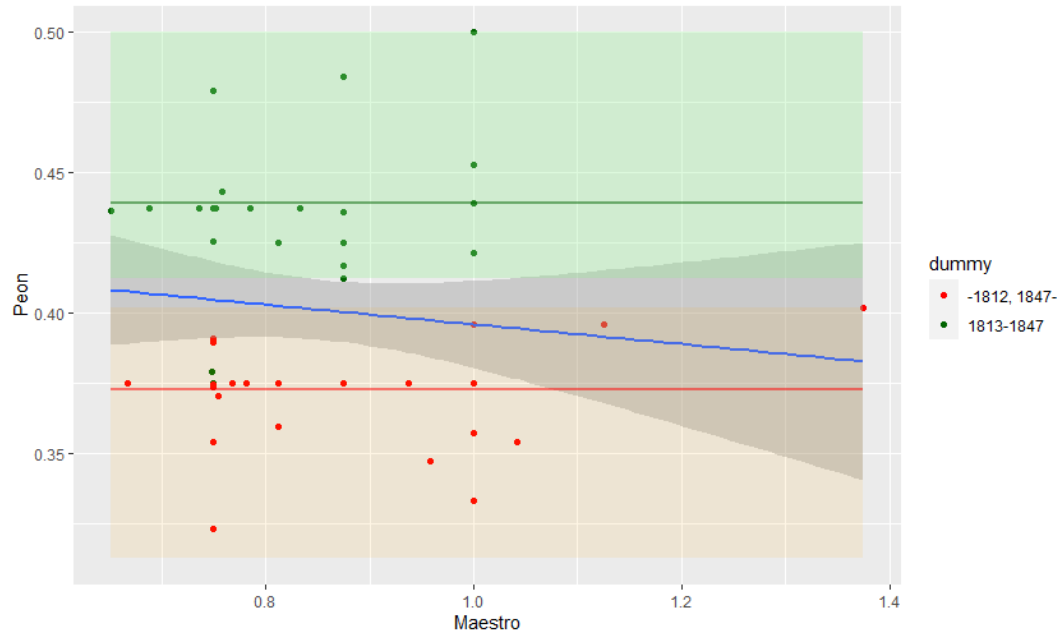


Figure A2. Clusters of mean *Peón* and *Oficiales* wages.

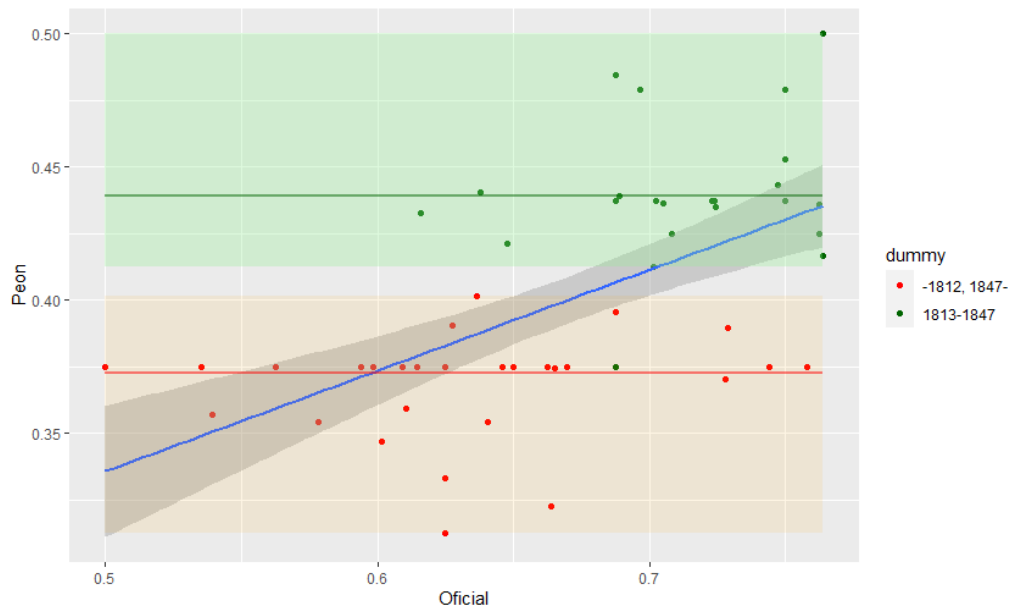
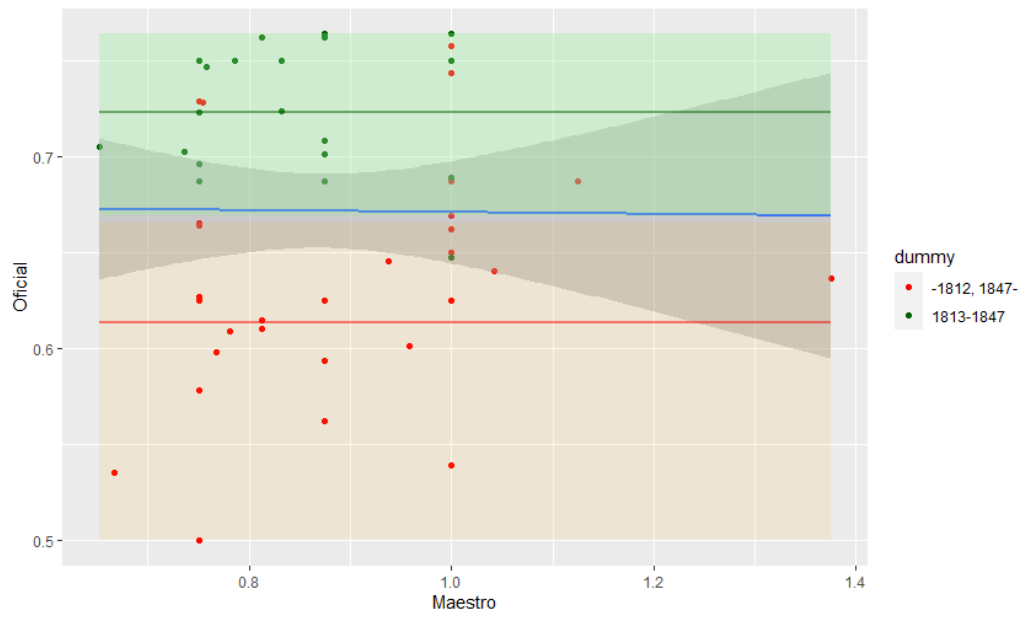


Figure A3. Clusters of Mean *Oficiales* and *Maestros* wages.
